# IS YOUR PURSUIT WORTH A LIFE?

Between 1982 and 2020, **13,381** people were killed during police pursuits - **the majority of which were *not* fleeing drivers.** Before engaging in a pursuit, consider whether the pursuit is worth the risk to officer and public safety.



# IS THERE A NEED FOR YOUR SPEED?

Between 1975 and 2020, 375 law enforcement officers died operating motor vehicles while driving too fast for conditions or at an excessive rate of speed.<sup>1</sup> Before you accelerate, remember, **speed is the strongest risk factor for a fatality in a motor vehicle collision.**<sup>2</sup>

# SEAT BELT AND VEST IS BEST

One study found that of the lives saved by ballistic vests, 42% of those saves occurred during a traffic collision. **Wearing your ballistic vest and your seat belt** during a vehicle collision can help protect your internal organs from damage.
