NO-COST SAFER TOGETHER COURSES

Safer Together Executive Briefing: This training, offered in-person and virtually, provides law enforcement executives with a brief, broad overview of this new national initiative to better understand the importance of encouraging their officers to attend Safer Together training and implement its principles in their agencies.

Safer Together Command-Level Forum: This engaging in-person session for command-level staff provides actionable skills and strategies to implement into your agency's culture that address challenging perceptions and help your people make the most of every interaction.

Safer Together Frontline Officer Workshop: This in-person workshop intended for frontline officers stresses the imperative of building trust as a foundational basis to improve relationships between officers and their community members, enhance safety and wellness, and reduce crime.

Safer Together Matchbook: This highly interactive course is conducted in three parts: a live, virtual session to kick off the training; a self-paced, online portion; and a live, virtual class to conclude. Officers will gain actionable skills and strategies that they can use to make the most of every interaction, which will result in reducing stress and enhancing everyone's safety and wellness.
