


BJA VALOR Special Bulletin: Fatal Attacks on Law Enforcement Officers Reach Alarming Levels

An unprecedented event is plaguing our nation as the number of law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty in 2016 reaches shocking levels. So far this year, 58 officers have been killed in the line of duty by gunfire; 20 were ambushed and killed, compared with 6 last year . . . that is more than a 300% increase in ambushes over the previous year. <u>*Read more*</u>
